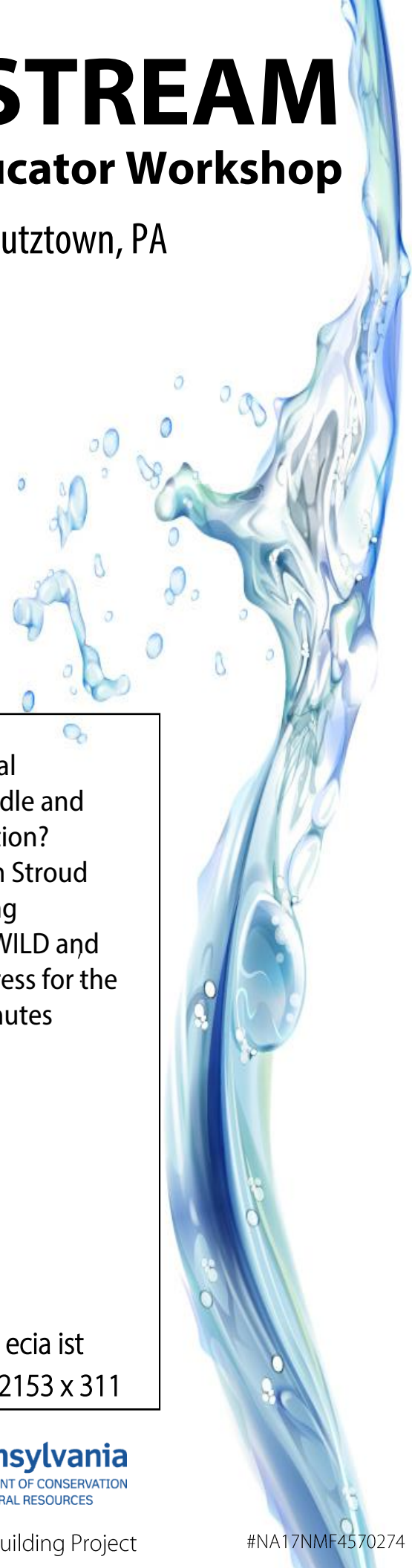


FROM LAND TO STREAM
