Thursday, September 12th (6.76 miles, beginner paddlers welcome)

10AM-4PM Paddle from ChesLen North Preserve to Shaw's Bridge Park

Friday, September 13th (11.17 miles, beginner paddlers welcome)

9AM-4PM Paddle from Shaw's Bridge Park to Brandywine Creek State Park's Thompson's Bridge

5PM-7PM Reception at Thompson's Bridge

Saturday, September 14th (10 mile morning paddle, EXPERIENCE PADDLERS ONLY. 3 mile afternoon paddle, beginner paddlers welcome)

7AM-2PM Paddle from Thompson's Bridge to Brandywine Park including occasional Class II white water, portaging 5 dams, and hiking Hagley Museum property.
EXPERIENCED PADDLERS ONLY.

12PM- 2PM Teachers and partners invited to take part in educational activities at Brandywine Park

2PM-5PM Paddle from Brandywine Park to the confluence of the Brandywine and the Christina, ending at 7th St. Boat Ramp. Beginner paddlers welcome, teachers from afternoon activities are encouraged to attend
